The purpose of this letter is to introduce myself as the Transition Coordinator at Devonport High School for Boys, to provide you with access to documents and information that we require from you and offer some helpful links that will aid the transition process for your son joining our school in September 2021.

## Documents we require:

## Information for you:

- **Modern Foreign Languages** - Currently all students at DHSB study a foreign language in year 7 and 8 and then the language studied can be continued as a GCSE option from year 9 onwards. The languages taught are one of either French, German or Spanish. The tutor group that your child is placed in will all study the same language from the start of year 7 onwards as a class, and the language will be designated based on staffing. If you have a strong preference for a particular language for your child to study (for example because you have a holiday home in Spain or because they already speak one of the languages on offer fluently) please can you specify this on the **student profile form**. If your child can already speak one of the languages

fluently, please select an alternative language to learn as a new MFL. We can provide support to bilingual students including early GCSE entry.

Please note that if a specific language is requested we cannot guarantee that we will be able to offer this but we will try to meet your request. It may however affect the possibility of your child being placed with a friend of choice in their tutor group. This should be carefully considered therefore before you specify a language preference.

- Virtual Tour If restrictions and guidance regarding COVID-19 change then we may be able to invite students onto the school site for a planned visit prior to September, however this is unlikely. You and your son can however familiarise yourself with the school and the facilities by using this link to access our <u>Virtual Tour</u>.
- Frequently asked questions The above Student Profile provides an opportunity for you to ask any questions that you or your child has but please take some time to read this <u>FAQ</u> <u>document</u> as you may find immediate answers. If there are any additional questions that have not been covered here please add them to the Student Profile.
- Future communication You will be added to the school's text messaging software and so you
  will be alerted when any communication has been sent. Please remember to check Spam/Junk
  mail folders, we have previously had issues with those who have Hotmail accounts not
  receiving letters to their inbox.

You can next expect to hear from me towards the end of May when your son will find out his Form Group allocation and be introduced to his Pastoral Team and other key members of staff. You will receive a Transition Pack via post which will include a booklet that contains four transition tasks for your son to complete and return to us in the folder provided when he starts at DHSB; some summer preparation activities for you and your son to get involved with; further reading and information. It is at this point that you will also receive information regarding the uniform ordering process.
